Glam Girl Lotion

Mini Quilt

Completed Mini Quilt Size: 7 ¼ inches wide x 10 ½ inches long

Foundation Pieced Block Size: 7 ½ inches square

Skill Level: Intermediate

What you will need:

1 completed foundation paper pieced Glam Girl Lotion Block (pattern attached). I used fabrics from my stash to make this block!

2 strips of white fabric that measure 2 inches x 7 ¼ inches

1 binding strip that measures 2 ¼ inches x 46 inches

1 backing fabric that measures 8 inches x 13 inches

1 quilt batting that measures 8 inches x 13 inches

Sewing Instructions:

1. Make your paper pieced lotion block. This is the fun part! Use your imagination on colors, prints and textures. Use some embroidery stitches to personalize your mini.



2. Trim the right side and the left side of your paper pieced block so that you have $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches of white fabric on the left side of the lotion and $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches of white fabric on the right side of the lotion. For trimming the block, I used the top left and right corners of the lotion bottle as my point of reference.
3. Sew one 2 inch x $7\frac{1}{4}$ inch white strip to the top of your lotion block.
4. Sew the remaining 2 inch x $7\frac{1}{4}$ inch white strip to the bottom of your lotion block.
5. Make a quilt sandwich placing the backing fabric on bottom (right side down), batting in the middle and then your mini quilt block (right side up).
6. Quilt your wall hanging using your favorite quilting technique(s). Trim off excess batting and backing fabric.
7. Add a hanging sleeve to the back of your wall hanging.
8. Make the $2\frac{1}{4}$ x 46 inch binding strip and sew the binding to your wall hanging.
9. Tack down the binding using your favorite technique.
