Glam Girl Nail Polish Mini Quilt

Completed Mini Quilt Size: 11 ½ inches x 11 ½ inches

Foundation Pieced Block Size: 7 ½ inches square

Skill Level: Intermediate

What you will need:

1 completed foundation paper pieced Glam Girl Nail Polish Block (pattern attached). I used fabrics from my stash to make this block!

2 strips of white fabric that measure 2 ½ inches x 11 ½ inches.

2 strips of white fabric that measure 2 ½ inches x 7 ½ inches

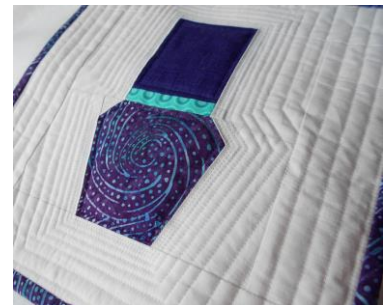
1 binding strip that measures 2 ¼ inches x 54 inches

1 backing fabric that measures 13 inches x 13 inches

1 quilt batting that measures 13 inches x 13 inches

Sewing Instructions:

1. Make your paper pieced block. This is the fun part!
Use your imagination on colors, prints and textures.
Use some embroidery stitches to personalize your cute little mini.
2. Square your paper pieced blocks to 7 ½ inches



3. Sew a 2 ½ x 7 ½ inch white strip to the left side of your nail polish block.
4. Sew the remaining 2 ½ x 7 ½ inch white strip to the right side of your nail polish block.
5. Sew a 2 ½ x 11 ½ inch white strip to the top of your nail polish block.
6. Sew a 2 ½ x 11 ½ inch white strip to the bottom of your nail polish block.
7. Make a quilt sandwich placing the backing fabric on bottom (right side down), batting in the middle and then your mini quilt block (right side up).
8. Quilt your wall hanging using your favorite quilting technique(s). Trim off excess batting and backing fabric.
9. Add a hanging sleeve to the back of your wall hanging.
10. Make the 2 ¼ x 54 inch binding strip and sew the binding to your wall hanging.
11. Tack down the binding using your favorite technique.
