


E-Heart Wall Quilt



Finished size = 40.5 x 40.5 inches Intermediate skill level

Materials

- 1 Red Jelly Roll
- 1 White Jelly Roll
- Red Embroidery Thread
- 1/3 Yard Red Fabric (for binding)
- 44" square backing
- 44" square batting



General Notes and Instructions

- All seam allowances = ¼ inch
- All fabrics are sewn with right sides together
- Press all seams open
- Assume width of fabric = 42"

32.5" strip (1)	8.5" strip (3)
30.5" strip (2)	6.5" strip (1)
24.5" strip (1)	4.5" strip (5)
24.5" strip (1) 22.5" strip (1)	2.5" square (9)
20.5" strip (1)	
18.5" strip (2)	
16.5" strip (3)	
14.5" strip (6)	
12.5" strip (1)	
10.5" strip (1)	
8.5" strip (4)	
6.5" strip (5)	
4.5" strip (5)	
binding fabric cut:	From the red 2.5" strip (5)



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Sewing Instructions

- Step 1: Lay out each row according to the diagram below.
- Step 2: Sew together the strips, squares and rectangles in each row and press seams.
- Step 3: Sew the rows together and press seams.
- Step 4: Embroider special words using red embroidery thread.
- Step 5: Layer backing, batting and quilt top and quilt using your favorite method.
- **Step 6:** Add a hanging sleeve to the back using your favorite method.
- Step 7: Piece the binding strips together and attach using your favorite binding method.
