

Spooky Scary Mug Rug

From green scraps for face, cut:

- (1) 4.5"x3.5" rectangle
- (4) 1.5" squares

From black scraps for hair, cut:

- (4) 1.5" squares

From 1 purple Fat Quarter cut:

For binding

- (2) strips 2.25" x 22"

For background

- (4) 1.0"x 2.0" rectangles
- (4) 1.0"x 2.25" rectangles

For borders

- (2) 4.5x1.5" strips
- (2) 8.5x1.5" strips

From gold/orange scraps for bolts, cut:

- (2) 1.0" x 1.0" squares
- (2) 1.0" x 1.75" rectangles

Other Materials:

- (2) googlie eyes
- Clothing snaps
- Quilter's glue
- Fabric for backing
- Quilt batting

Tip: Use inexpensive clothing snaps to attach cute googlie eyes to Frank N. Stein. Then when the mug run needs to be laundered, the googlies can be easily removed.

- Finished Size = 8.5 x 6.5 inches
- All seam allowances = ¼ inch
- All fabrics are sewn with right sides together unless otherwise noted
- Press all seams toward dark fabric unless otherwise noted

.25 inch = 1/4 inch


.50 inch = 1/2 inch

.75 inch = 3/4 inch



Frank's Hair

1. Choose **four** 1.5" black squares and place them right side up on your work surface. Using a thin pencil, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of four 1.5" green squares and place it right side down on top of black white square. Sew from corner to corner along the diagonal line (Diagram 1).



2. Use a ruler to mark off the 1/4" seam allowance, trim and press the seams (Diagram 2). You should now have four black and green half square triangles.




3. Lay out the squares for the hair as shown in Diagram 3 and sew them together. Press seams open to reduce bulk.



Frank's Face

4. Sew the row from step 3 to the 4.5" x 3.5" green Rectangle (Diagram 4). Press seam toward 4.5"x3.5" green rectangle.



Frank's Bolts

5. Referring to the Diagram 5, sew the purple rectangles to the gold squares and rectangles in the order shown. You will have four units of purple and gold.



Frank's Bolts (cont'd)

6. Sew Unit 1 to Unit 2 and Unit 3 to Unit 4 in the order shown in Diagram 6. Press seams open to reduce bulk.



7. Sew the combined unit 1 and 2 to the left side of Frank's face. Next sew the combined unit 3 and 4 to the right side of Frank's face (Diagram 7). Press seams.



Finish Frank

8. Sew a 1.5" x 4.5" purple strip to the left side of Dracula and another 1.5 x 4.5" purple strip to the right side of Frank (Diagram 8).

9. Sew a 1.5" x 8.5" purple strip to the top of Frank and a 1.5" x 8.5" strip to the bottom of Dracula (Diagram 8).



Finish Frank (cont'd)

10. Quilt Frank using your favorite method.
11. Sew the two 2.25" x 22" binding strips together and attach the binding to Frank using your favorite method.
12. Sew the bottom snaps to Frank... where his eyes should be.
13. Glue googlie eyes to the top snaps. Allow to dry and then snap them into place.
14. Cut eyebrows from black scraps and glue into place.

Tip: You can skip the snaps and just glue the googlie eyes to the mug rug!

Enjoy a hot mug of something wonderful on your new mug rug!
