**Completed Quilt Size: 42x44**


## Quilting Math

**$1/4$  inch = .25 inch**

**$1/2$  inch = .5 inch**

**$3/4$  inch = .75 inch**

***" is the symbol for inch***



## Materials Needed

- (1) 16.5x42.5" strip of feature fabric
- (1) 8.5x43.5" strip of complementary fabric
- (1) 4.5x42.5" strip of accent fabric
- (8) assorted 8.5"x8.5" squares
- (2) 4.5"x 8.5" rectangles
- (4) 4.5" squares

## Other Fabric

- 2 Yards Backing Fabric
- 3/4 Yard Binding Fabric ( cut 9 strips that measure 2.5 inches x Width of Fabric (WOF)
- Quilt Batting

# Baby Frolic

## Sewing Instructions:

**Step 1:** Assemble feature fabric, complimentary fabric and accent fabric pieces and sew them together, creating a featured fabric unit.

**Step 2:** Begin the patchwork unit. Sew together three (3) sets of two 8.5" squares patches. Reserve two 8.5" squares for step 4.

**Step 3.** Using all four 4.5" squares, sew together 2 sets of 4.5" squares

**Step 4.** Using the remaining two 8.5" squares from step 2, attach a 4.5"x8.5" rectangle to one side of each square. Then on the opposite side of the square, attach one of the 4.5" sets created in step 3.

**Step 5.** Follow the diagram on page one and sew the blocks created in step 2, 3 and 4 together to create the patchwork unit.

Step 6. Sew the patchwork unit to the featured fabric unit.

### Gray Barn Design Notes

- \* All seams are 1/4 inch , unless otherwise noted in instructions
- \* Assume width of fabric = 42 inches
- \* Press seams as indicated

## Finish the Quilt:

**Step 1:** Layer the backing fabric, batting and quilt top. Quilt using your favorite quilting technique.

**Step 2:** Sew the 2.5 inch binding strips together and attach to the quilt using your favorite binding technique.
