

Sugar Skull Wall Hanging

Decorate to celebrate your late October tradition, be it Halloween, All Saints Day, or Dia De Los Muertos. You'll love this mini sugar skull quilt to add a bit of charm to your celebration plans. This is a beginner and scrap-friendly pattern.

Completed Quilt Size: 30"x30"

Quilting Math

1/4 inch = .25 inch

1/2 inch = .5 inch

3/4 inch = .75 inch

" is the symbol for inch



Materials Needed

Scraps	Fat Quarters
(257) Black 2" squares	4
(2) Black 4"x6" rectangles	
(2) Black 2"x4" rectangles	
(119) White 2" squares	2
(38) Purple 2" squares	1
(9) Lime green 2" squares	1
(2) Gold 2"x4" rectangle	1

If you purchase fat quarters, use the Scraps list for cutting instructions.

Other Fabric

- 1 yard backing fabric
- 1/2 yard binding fabric

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Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Assemble the (2) plain black background rows at the top. Then assemble forehead in rows using diagram, right.

Step 2: Assemble both temple patches and the bridge of the nose, then attach 4"x6" black eye sockets. Sew patches together to create the temple/eye socket/bridge of nose unit.

Step 3. Assemble the cheek bones and attach to the 2"x4" 'nostril' rectangles. Assemble and attach the background squares. Sew left and right nostril units together, attach to the temple/eye socket/bridge of nose unit created in Step 2.

Step 4. Assemble upper lip row; attach to the completed Step 3 unit.

Step 5. Assemble the cheek and mouth units (make 2). Sew (2) 2" square units together and attach one to each 2"x4" gold 'tooth' rectangle. Sew teeth together, attach cheek units. Attach to the completed step 4 unit.

Step 6. Assemble the chin and lower background squares attach to the Step 5 unit in rows.



Gray Barn Design Notes

- * All seams are 1/4 inch , unless otherwise noted in instructions
- * Assume width of fabric = 42 inches
- * Press seams as indicated

Finish the Quilt:

For reference, there are (21) 2" squares across the top and the bottom.

Step 1: Layer the backing fabric, batting and quilt top. Quilt using your favorite quilting technique.

Step 2: Sew the 2.5 inch binding strips together and attach to the quilt using your favorite binding technique.
